HOW TO ENTER

The Contest begins at 12:01AM (E.S.T.) on February 5, 2017 and all entries must be received by 11:59P.M. (E.S.T.) on April 30, 2017. Submit an online one hundred (100) word essay on why you would like to be considered for a makeover with Lloyd Boston. The winner will be notified on June 1, 2017.

CCWC will not be responsible for incomplete, late, "post-due," misdirected or illegible entries or for failure to receive entries for any reason. All entries become the property of CCWC and no portion of the entry will be returned.

ELIGIBILITY

To enter and be eligible to participate, you must, at the time of entry be 18 years of age or older and a legal resident of the 50 United States and District of Columbia. The Contest is void outside the 50 United States and District of Columbia, and where prohibited. If won, the prize cannot be transferred to another person or entity.
