Come be our summer 2021 intern! Corporate Counsel Women of Color® (CCWC) is a not-for-profit organization of over 4,500 in-house women attorneys of color in the United States, as well as Canada, Asia, Africa, and Europe.

CCWC is seeking a student who has completed one or two years of law school for a paid summer job. This internship and trainee program will report directly to the Founder, President and Chief Executive Officer of CCWC.

The responsibilities of this role include:

- Legal Research;
- Legal Writing;
- Legal Analysis;
- Contract Review; and
- Assistance on projects involving non-profit law, compliance, privacy, copyright and trademarks, and more.

Qualities in a candidate that would make a great fit include attention to detail, a self-starting personality, follow-through, curiosity, an interest in a future career as an in-house attorney, and a passion for diversity in the legal profession.

This intern will work remotely for CCWC, so your location can be anywhere as long as your working hours are compatible with Eastern Standard Time. The duration of your internship will be nine weeks, between June 2, 2021 and August 2, 2022. Hours will average approximately 35 per week at a flat rate of \$5,000.00 for the summer.
