In December 2020, CCWC was invited by NASDAQ to submit a comment letter to the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission. In-house corporate attorneys have become increasingly influential as strategic advisors to senior leaders, managers and business unit teams on issues and transactions related to business growth.
