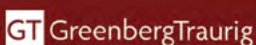

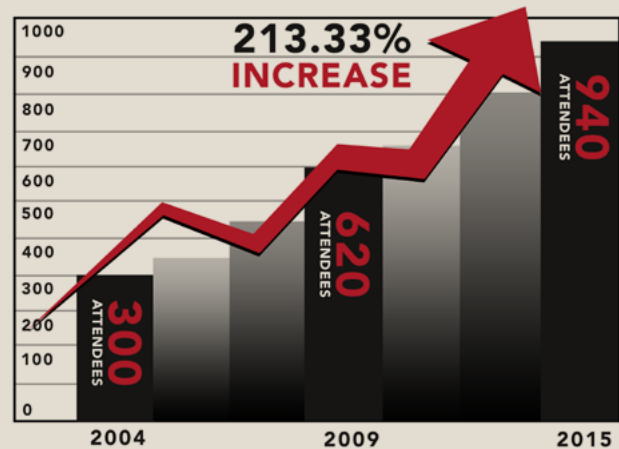

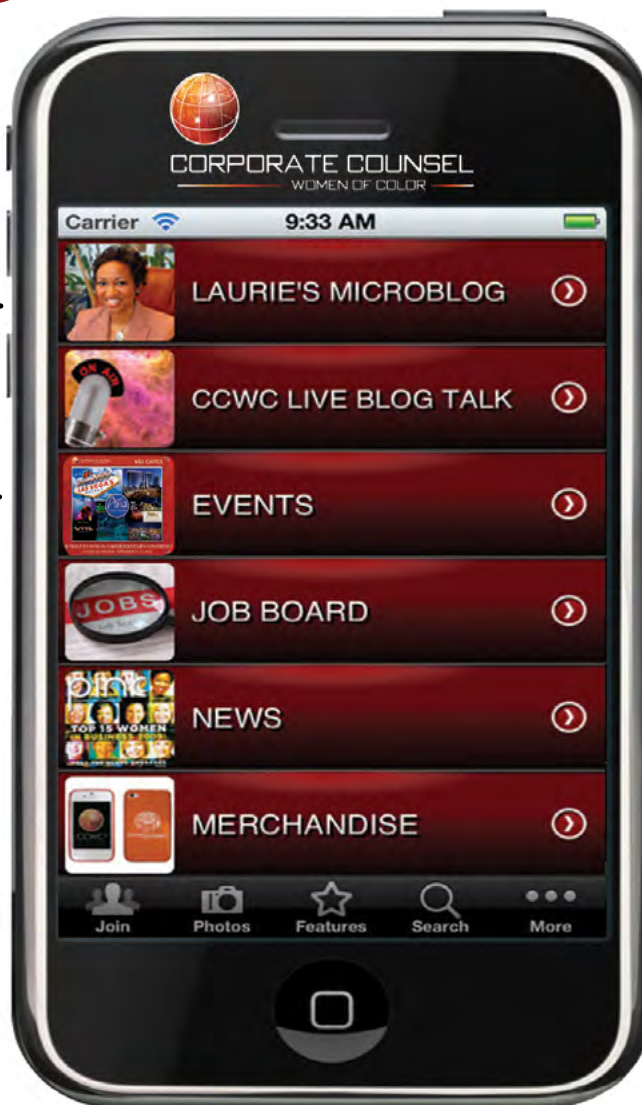

Atlanta, Georgia – Atlanta was a big hit! Over 900 women of color attorneys – a record number – gathered in Atlanta, Georgia for the Corporate Counsel Women of Color and K&L Gates LLP 11th Annual Conference September 23-25, 2015.

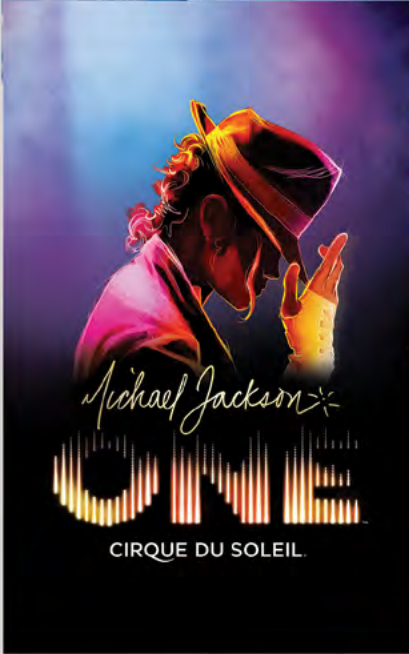

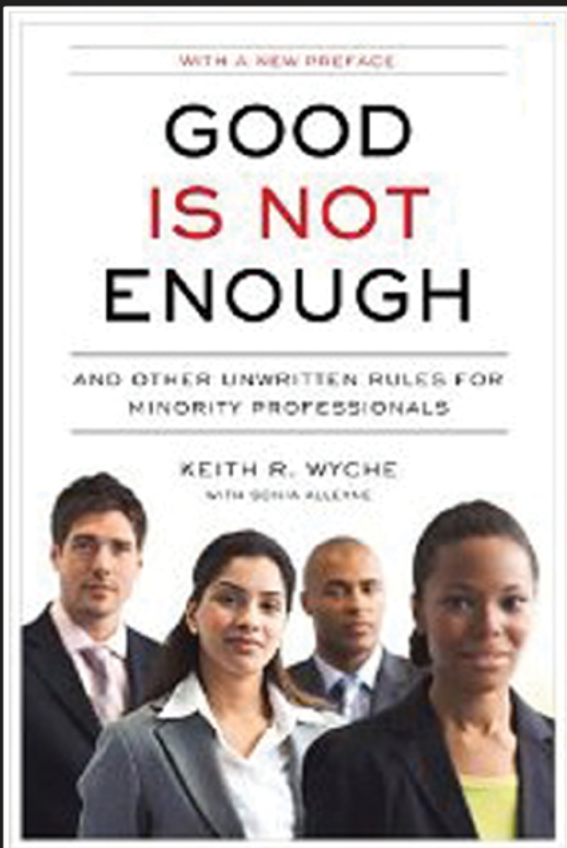

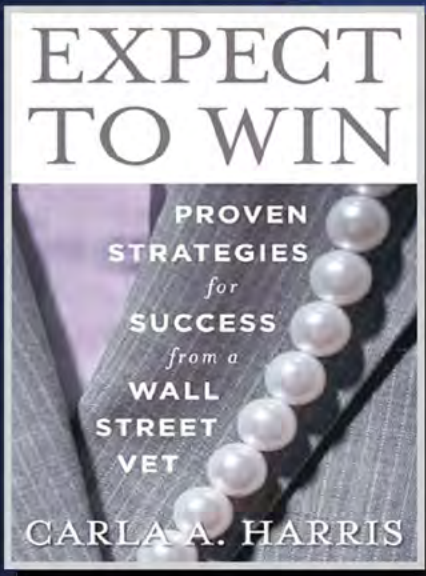
