In connection with our mission to foster diversity and empowerment, we launched our groundbreaking men of color workplace survey, which hundreds of men have already taken, I am happy to report.

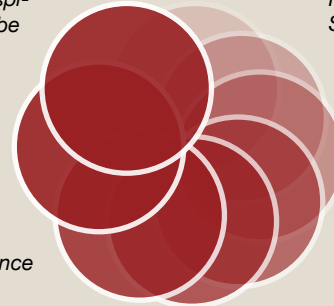

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5 SUCCESSFUL STRATEGIES FOR IN-HOUSE AND LAW FIRM WOMEN ATTORNEYS OF COLOR

At the Corporate Counsel Women of Color and K&L Gates LLP 2016 Conference in Las Vegas, law firm and in-house women of color participated in the think-tank panel, "Women of Color and Diversity & Inclusion at Firms and in Corporations 2017 Solutions."

In terms of challenges, common themes were identified as barriers at both law firms and corporations. The think-tank fashioned proactive solutions together for the legal profession to follow.

THE CHALLENGE

CHALLENGE

1

ACCESS TO HIGH-PROFILE ASSIGNMENTS AND CLIENTS

Women of color face the challenge of gaining access to high-profile clients and high-profile assignments.

CHALLENGE

2

BEING TAGGED AS THE "DE FACTO" DIVERSITY PERSON

Women of color are tagged by the firm and corporation as the "de facto" go-to diversity person.

CHALLENGE

3

GETTING ORIENTATION CREDIT

Women of color are not properly given origination credit for work they have earned and should be credited with.

CHALLENGE

4

MOVING UP & ADVANCEMENT

Attorneys of color and women attorneys are much less likely to have sponsors – i.e., partners and senior executives of influence within their organizations who are personally invested in their success.

CHALLENGE

5

DEVELOPING KEY RELATIONSHIPS

Women of color face the challenge of developing key relationships and internal networks.

SOLUTION

1

THE SOLUTION

MONITOR AND DIVERSIFY STAFFING

To ensure access to opportunity, corporations should actively monitor the use of diverse and women of color attorneys on their matters. Corporations should also ensure that the firm's largest clients, RFPs, client pitches, AFAs, and secondments are staffed with diverse and women of color attorneys.

SOLUTION

2

MAKE EVERYONE RESPONSIBLE FOR DIVERSITY

To avoid pigeonholing, organizations should ensure that everyone is responsible for diversity and inclusion at the firm, especially with the firm leadership and ensure it does not fall to only the diverse attorneys. In cases when the diverse attorney is tasked with extra diversity and inclusion expectations, it should be used as a matrix for measuring their value.

SOLUTION

3

ACTIVELY MONITOR BILLING CREDIT

Law firm and practice group leaders (and in-house counsel) should actively monitor billing and origination credit and designation of the client relationship partner to ensure diverse and women of color attorneys are being treated fairly and have opportunities.

SOLUTION

4

ADDRESS INFORMAL SYSTEMS BY CREATING FORMAL PROGRAMS

A formal sponsorship program can address inequities by identifying existing and potential sponsors, and supporting and tracking those relationships. Such programs can put women of color in front of the right people, help them get the level of work they need to develop their skills, and provide advocates to help advance their careers.

SOLUTION

5

CREATE ROTATION OPPORTUNITIES

To provide assignments that grow and expand the attorney, law firms and corporations should create rotation opportunities so that law firm and in-house attorneys have the opportunity to gain experience in varying subject areas.
