



THE CHALLENGE

CHALLENGE

ACCESS TO HIGH-PROFILE ASSIGNMENTS AND CLIENTS

Women of color face the challenge of gaining access to high-profile clients and high-profile assignments.

CHALLENGE 2

BEING TAGGED AS THE "DE FACTO" DIVERSITY PERSON

Women of color are tagged by the firm and corporation as the "de facto" go-to diversity person.

CHALLENGE 3

GETTING **ORIGINATION CREDIT**

Women of color are not properly given origination credit for work they have earned and should be credited with.

CHALLENGE 4

MOVING UP & ADVANCEMENT

Attorneys of color and women attorneys are much less likely to have sponsors - i.e., partners and senior executives of influence within their organizations who are personally invested in their success.

CHALLENGE 5

DEVELOPING **KEY RELATIONSHIPS**

Women of color face the challenge of developing key relationships and internal networks.

CREATE ROTATION OPPORTUNITIES

To provide assignments that grow and expand the attorney, law firms and corporations should create rotation opportunities so that law firm and in-house attorneys have the opportunity to gain experience in varying subject areas.

THE SOLUTION

In terms of challenges, common themes were identified as barriers at both law firms and corporations. The think-tank fashioned

proactive solutions together for the legal profession to follow.

MONITOR AND DIVERSIFY STAFFING

To ensure access to opportunity, corporations should actively monitor the use of diverse and women of color attorneys on their matters. Corporations should also ensure that the firm's largest clients, RFPs, client pitches, AFAs, and secondments are staffed with diverse and women of color attorneys.

MAKE EVERYONE **RESPONSIBLE FOR DIVERSITY**

To avoid pigeonholing, organizations should ensure that everyone is responsible for diversity and inclusion at the firm, especially with the firm leadership and ensure it does not fall to only the diverse attorneys. In cases when the diverse attorney is tasked with extra diversity and inclusion expectations, it should be used as a matrix for measuring their value.

ACTIVELY MONITOR BILLING CREDIT

Law firm and practice group leaders (and in-house counsel) should actively monitor billing and origination credit and designation of the client relationship partner to ensure diverse and women of color attorneys are being treated fairly and have opportunities.

ADDRESS INFORMAL SYSTEMS BY CREATING FORMAL PROGRAMS




