Having the capability to understand business and financial concepts is a real advantage. As corporate counsel, your job often includes advising management on legal issues which impact important business decisions. Doing this effectively may require you to understand key financial concepts, such as information presented in financial statements and valuation methods used in strategic decision making. In collaboration with Deloitte, we will host an advance financial acumen program. The most effective in-house attorneys understand, not only, the breadth of legal issues facing their companies, they also recognize the importance of how those issues affect can influence strategic business decisions.

The program will begin with a refresher of the basics of accounting concepts, financial statements, and US GAAP accounting principles as well as valuation principles and theory (i.e. what is valuation, who needs it, and common litigation issues).
