NEW YORK CITY ANOTHER MONUMENTAL YEAR!

Thomas Wolfe wrote, "You can never go home again." He was wrong. You can! Corporate Counsel Women of Color held its first five conferences in New York City before going on the road. After several road trips, home beckoned, and we hosted our 14th Annual Conference in New York once again! It felt good to be back where it all began—the Big Apple—New York City!

The 2018 Corporate Counsel and K&L Gates LLP 14th Annual Career Strategies Conference represented yet another milestone for the organization. Specifically, last year's event sold out in record time (by May 2018) and brought together over 1,200 attendees from around the United States—another record number.

We rolled out a great year of programming and events for attendees in New York. Our signature Boot Camp and MBA for Lawyers garnered 6 hours of Continuing Legal Education credit and offered new courses including the Corporate Board Boot Camp and Political Candidate Readiness for 2020 Boot Camp. An interactive group game, Escape the Room, was provided for the first time. Teams of 6-8 persons combined wits to find clues that would enable them to escape from the room.
